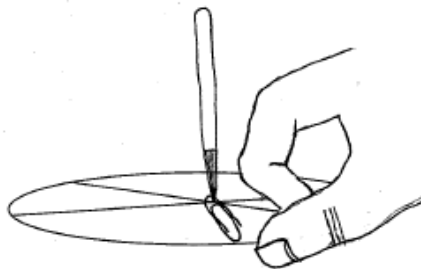


Question spinners

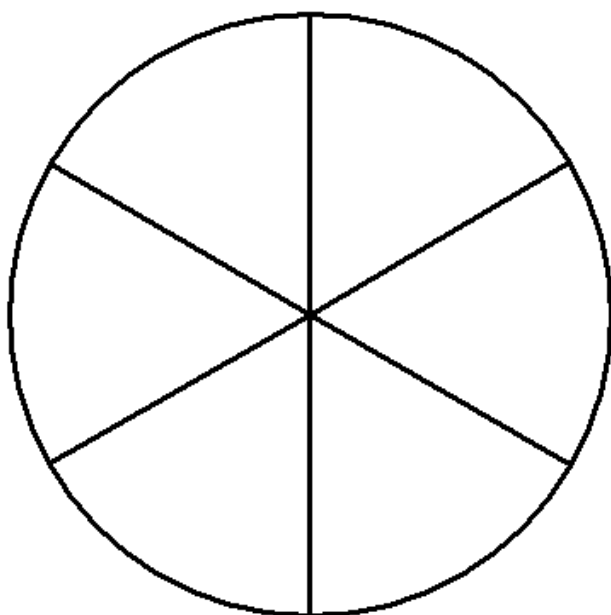
You will need:

- two pencils
- two paper clips.

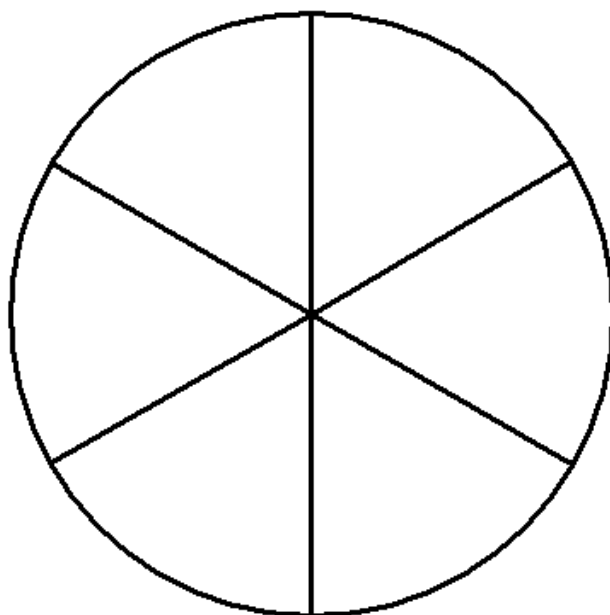


What to do:

1. Record 'Who', 'What', 'Where', 'When', 'Why' and 'How' on Spinner 1.
2. Record 'did', 'could', 'would', 'was', 'were' and 'might' on Spinner 2.
3. Place the paper clips and pencils in the middle of the spinner. Hold the tops of the pencils.
4. Ask your partner to spin the paper clips. (See illustration above.)
5. Record the stem of each question.
6. Use the stem of the question to write a question; for example:
 - If 'How' and 'might' were spun a possible question could be, 'How might the lives of Australian women be different today if Edith Cowan (and women like her) had not been born?'
